Proudly founded by refugees in 1981, Chinese Mutual Aid Association serves the needs, promotes the interest, and enhances the well-being of diverse immigrant and refugee communities across Metropolitan Chicago through social services, advocacy, educational programming, and assistance for clients of all ages. Since our founding, CMAA has evolved into a pan-immigrant social services agency, serving clients from over 40 countries representing Asia, Africa, Eastern Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East. With our wraparound service model, CMAA serves 5,000 clients annually. With offices in Uptown, Elgin, and West Ridge, we currently offer job preparation & placement services, youth programming, adult education, English as a Second Language (ESL) classes, in-home elderly care services, immigration and citizenship case assistance, and an Economic Development Center. CMAA Program Overview

CMAA's programs serve our community across generations. We offer after-school, summer camp, and mentoring programs for young people. For adults, we provide case management and social services, education, including English as a Second Language (ESL) classes, job preparation and placement services, and immigration and citizenship case assistance. We connect older adults to in-home care support and community through our Golden Age Club. Finally, we support entrepreneurs and small business owners through our Economic Development Center.

CMAA PROGRAMS



Adult Education & Workforce Development

CMAA's Adult Education and Workforce Development Department partners with individuals from diverse immigrant populations to realize their personal, educational, and professional goals by providing quality tailored curriculum, instruction, and case management. Managers Udon Thao and Amien Hendricks lead a consortium of 5 partner organizations, offering English as a Second Language (ESL) and Adult Basic Education to hundreds of adults annually and coordinating one-on-one and small group tutoring for clients needing additional support. CMAA's Transitions Case Managers connect all learners to the wraparound services vital to class retention and partner with clients to create plans to meet their long-term educational goals. CMAA's Workforce Development program works on a spectrum to support students and clients in their short and long-term career goals. Clients looking for good jobs meet with our Workforce Career Coaches for individualized case management to assess skills, build a resume, apply for jobs, prepare for interviews, and more.

Citizenship

As an organization founded by refugees, CMAA's Citizenship Department is at the core of our mission to support diverse immigrant communities in becoming naturalized US citizens. Citizenship Manager Lilli Dang leads the department with over 20 years of experience in assisting clients at every step in the naturalization process. Our immigration attorney, caseworkers, and instructors provide application processing services, citizenship education, and interview preparation. CMAA is certified by the US Department of Justice to provide immigration legal services. In the past year, we filed 236 immigration applications and 108 clients became citizens.

CMAA PROGRAMS



Care for Older Adults

With over 20 years of experience, CMAA's In-Home Care program provides high-quality culturally sensitive services, empowering older adults and individuals with disabilities to live independently in the comfort of their own homes. For older adults who do not qualify for Medicaid, our Golden Wings Home Care program offers self-pay in-home care. Under the leadership of Manager Tim Calalang, CMAA delivers over 250,000 hours of care to hundreds of residents in Cook and Kane County. Recognizing that social connectedness is a strong indicator of longevity for aging adults, especially for immigrant adults, CMAA launched our Golden Age Club. Golden Age Club promotes the well-being of elders by creating opportunities for them to meet regularly and build community with each other. CMAA's In-Home Care, Golden Wings Home Care, and Golden Age Club bring care and togetherness to important community members.

Business Development

After becoming certified as an Illinois Small Business Development Center (SBDC) in 2020, CMAA has offered support to 826 small businesses and entrepreneurs, serving the highest number of AANHPI clients of all 40 of the state's SBDCs by more than double. As a Thai immigrant and entrepreneur, Director Chettha Saetia and his team provide culturally competent small business consulting and develop workshops and webinars to support business owners from all backgrounds. Now a Neighborhood Business Development Center with the City of Chicago's Bureau of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and an APEX Accelerator with the Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity, CMAA provides no-cost business development, including permit guidance, technical assistance, and government contract procurement.

Social Services

CMAA's Social Services program supports immigrant and refugee families by providing case management, language support, and assistance in accessing a wide range of valuable community resources and information. Our diverse team speaks the languages our clients speak, including Cantonese, Burmese, Mandarin, and Vietnamese, allowing clients to feel comfortable, speak freely, and receive service in their native languages. Last year, our Social Services team provided outreach and translation services and secured food assistance, energy assistance, and Medicaid for 1500 clients.

Youth Department

CMAA's Youth Department supports immigrant-origin students from kindergarten through college graduation. We provide after-school and summer camp programs for younger students with our Diverse Young Leaders (DYL) program, while adolescent students build leadership skills in our cohort-based mentoring programs, Young Women Warriors (YWW) and Young Men Making Moves (YMMM). These programs support and honor the strengths of immigrant-origin, refugee, and BIPOC youth living in Chicago's northside immigrant-rich neighborhoods. Our Youth Department provides over 1,000 service hours annually, reaching 200 students. Students receive academic support, engage in cultural arts, and nurture healthy relationships in safe spaces with adults and peers. At the end of last year's school year, 100% of graduating high school students enrolled in post-secondary education. CMAA's Lion and Lotus Dancers, who practice weekly as part of our after-school program, will perform tonight!

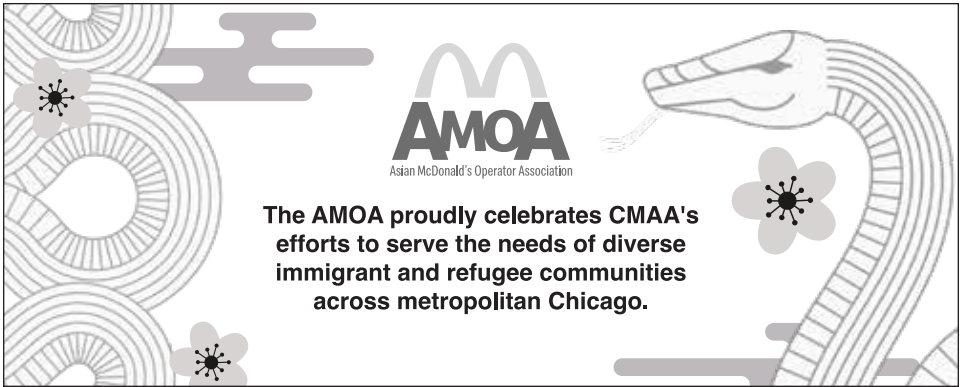
